

# Handful of Berries

mittens

a free pattern from **Fairmount Fibers**  
designed by Jocelyn J. Tunney



## FINISHED SIZES

Circumference around palm: 7.5"

## MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay Maxima (100g, approx. 218yds; 100% merino wool), 1 sk. Shown in M7158 Mixed Berries.

US 8/5mm double-pointed needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

US 6/4mm double-pointed needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

1 stitch marker

Stitch holder

## GAUGE

19 sts and 27 rows = 4"/10cm over St st with larger needles

## ABBREVIATIONS

k1f&b=Knit into the front and back loop of the same stitch (1 st increased).

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## LEFT MITTEN

Using larger needles, cast on 36 sts. Join for working in the round, being careful not to twist stitches. Place marker indicating beginning of round. Change to smaller needles and work in K2, P2 ribbing for 22 rounds. Change to larger needles.

Decrease round: \*K7, k2tog; repeat from \* 3 more times. (32 sts) K 4 rounds.

Begin gusset shaping:

Rnd 1: K5, k1f&b, place marker, k to end of rnd. (33 sts)

Rnds 2 through 10: K to 1 st before marker, k1f&b, k to end of rnd. 42 sts at end of Rnd 10.

Divide for Thumb:

Rnd 11: K16, place the next 10sts on holder, k to end of rnd. (32 working sts on needles)

Hand:

Work St st for 26 more rnds.

Shape Top of Hand:

Rnd 1: (Ssk, k12, k2tog) twice. (28 sts)

Rnd 2: (Ssk, k10, k2tog) twice. (24 sts)

Rnd 3: (Ssk, k8, k2tog) twice. (20 sts)

Rnd 4: (Ssk, k6, k2tog) twice. (16 sts)

Rnd 5: (Ssk, k4, k2tog) twice. (12 sts)

Rnd 6: (Ssk, k2, k2tog) twice. (8 sts)

Rnd 7: (Ssk, k2tog) twice. (4 sts)

Break yarn, thread through rem sts and cinch closed.

Thumb:

Divide 10 sts on holder onto larger dpns. Set-up rnd: Knit 10 sts, pick up and k 4 sts across thumb gap. (14 sts) Next rnd: K10, K2tog, K2tog. (12 sts) Knit 9 rounds or desired length to fit thumb.

Shape top of thumb:

Rnd 1: K2tog around (6 sts).

Rnd 2: K2tog around (3 sts).

Break yarn, thread through rem sts and cinch closed.

## RIGHT MITTEN

Work the same as for left mitten, substituting the following sections for "Begin gusset increasing" and "Divide for thumb":

Begin gusset increasing:

Rnds 1-10: K10, K1f&b, k to end of rnd. (42 sts)

Divide for thumb:

Rnd 11: Place the first 10sts on holder, k to end of rnd. (32 working sts on needles)

## FINISHING

Weave in ends, block.
