

Montevideo Capelet

a free pattern from **Fairmount Fibers**
designed by Jocelyn J. Tunney

FINISHED SIZES

Circumference around shoulders: SM (38"), LG(42")

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay Maxima (100g, approx. 218yds; 100% merino wool), 4 sk. Shown in M7602 Grapevine.

24" circular needle, US 13/9mm OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

2 markers

GAUGE

11 sts and 16 rows = 4"/10cm over Moss st with two strands of yarn held together

Moss Stitch (multiple of 2 sts)

Rnds 1 and 2: (k1, p1) around.

Rnds 3 and 4: (p1, k1) around.

Repeat rnds 1-4 for Moss Stitch.

ABBREVIATIONS

m1k = with left-hand needle, lift strand between st just worked and next st from front to back, k through back loop.

m1p = with left-hand needle, lift strand between st just worked and next st from front to back, p through back loop.

pm = place marker

DIRECTIONS

Using 2 strands of yarn held together throughout, CO 110 (122) sts. Join, being careful not to twist. Pm to show beginning of rnd and after 55 (61) sts. Work in Moss Stitch for 7".

SHAPE SHOULDERS

Rnds 1, 3, 5-17: *Ssk, work Moss st as est to 2 sts before marker, k2tog, slm, rep from * to end of rnd. 4 sts decreased.

Rnds 2 and 4: *K1, work Moss st as est to st before marker, k1, slm, rep from * to end of rnd.

50 (62) sts rem after Round 17.

WORK NECK

Work in Moss St as est for 6.5".

INCREASE FOR COWL

Rnd 1: P1, m1p or m1k depending on where you are in Moss st, work Moss st as est to last st before marker, m1p or m1k depending on where you are in Moss st, p1, slm, rep from * to end of rnd. 4 sts increased.

Maintaining Moss St as est, rep Rnd 1 12 times more. 102 (114) sts.

BO purlwise.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Steam block lightly.
